Wiley P.'s mother was supposedly Hannah Gray, but I have found no proof of that. His mother died and his father married again in Coosa County, Alabama. The family lived there until the late 1890's when they moved to Sycamore in Talladega County. Cotton mills were just beginning, and they were seen as a great opportunity.
